Police, fire, and emergency personnel all have their own access to our community. In addition, the Hibiscus Lane gate will only be open in an emergency such as a mandatory hurricane evacuation.. Management is doing it's best to provide a safe and secure place to live, so please do not loan or give your transmitter to anybody. If you have purchased a transmitter for a relative, please be aware that you, as the resident, are responsible for their actions.

Reminder: If any committee has an evening activity (after 7:00 pm) that depends on outside participation, the committee must appoint someone with a gate transmitter to monitor the opening of the security gate. The security gate allows exit access automatically.

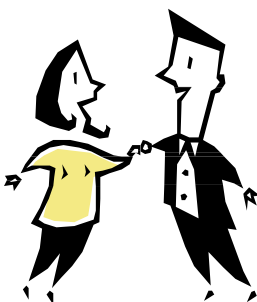
