All residents are invited to a Fourth of July Party being held at the clubhouse on Friday, July 3 at Noon.

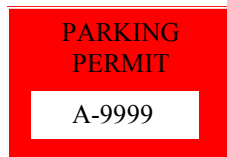

As a reminder, all permanent residents whether they are here year round or 6/6 residents must register their vehicle(s) with the office. There is no charge to the residents and you will be provided with a Static Cling Parking Permit that will not harm your vehicle. The Permit will go on the inside of the rear window, driver's side. If you registered your vehicle last year and have traded your vehicle since, you need to update your new vehicle information at the office. If you did not remember to transfer the parking permit to your new vehicle you will need to get a new permit for your vehicle and re-register it.

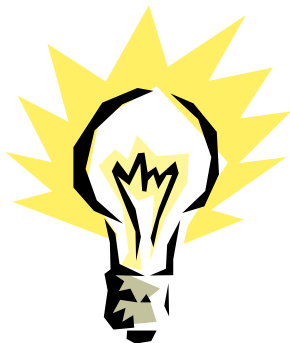
