Linda Lockett of 2475 Mountain Laurel Lane had her thyroid cancer check up and all is good.

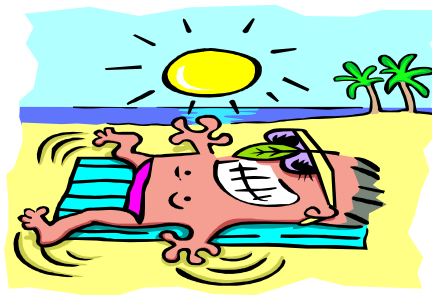
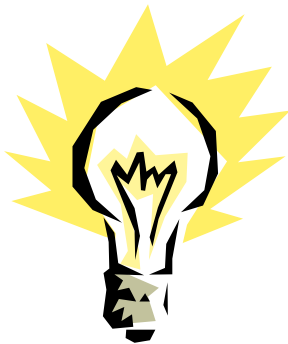
