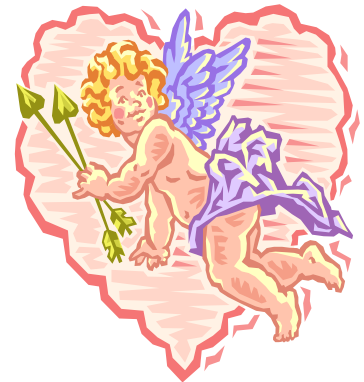

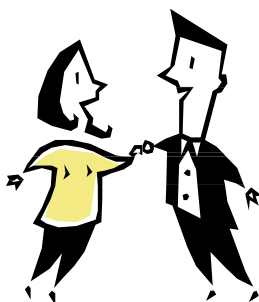

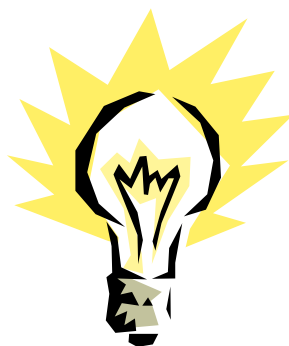
RESIDENTS NEWS...
