Please note that the party is the day before the Fourth.



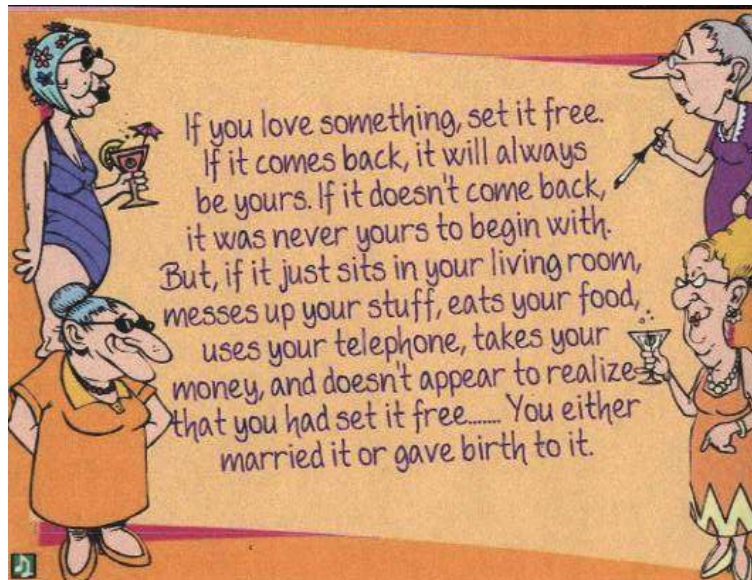
HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

Bert and Becky Levasseur of 2451 Apple Blossom Lane have moved back into their home in the park. Welcome back to Bert & Becky.

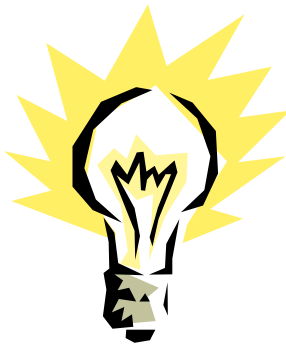
